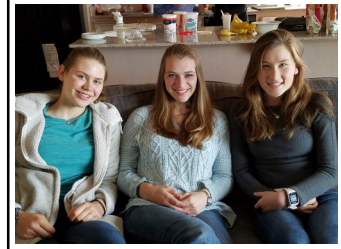
# Paradise Adventist Academy
