PARADISE ADVENTIST ACADEMY UPDATE!



- PAA has completed the first week of school in its 2019-2020 school year!
- Off to a good start: 51 students enrolled in the high school division. (There were 63 enrolled at the same time last year, but this year's enrollment is still higher than three years ago!) There are 151 students enrolled in the elementary level. This year's budget was based on a total of 200 students.
- There is a good spirit on campus!
- The High School had a delightful time at the campout which occurred last weekend!
- The ASB leaders are stepping up to the plate in their various offices.
- The Gym is now cleaned out so that structural and electrical repairs can begin!
- The Grades 5-8 Building has had a new roof and gutters put on and the asbestos ceiling is being removed.

WHAT IS TO COME OF THE CARILLON ON THE PAC CAMPUS?

After an extended 90-minute discussion considering: the history, sentimental attachment, pain of additional loss, cost of reinforcing the structure if kept, cost to remove it later if we delay our decision, no additional clean up cost if it is removed now, and the impact of the structure on future visions for the property, the Church Board (with 19 present) unanimously voted to proceed with the removal of the carillon. The board requested that the contractor delay that event until early next week to give our members time to visit, photograph, and grieve the loss of this monument. It is our intent to preserve the plaque on the structure and it's story for display in a suitable fashion when the campus is rebuilt.
