Our PAC Ministries Fund: The Good, the Bad, and the Challenge! The Good News: As of November 30, our YTD deficit/shortfall is \$71,000 (or 37%) lower than last year! The Bad News: Our YTD donations are down \$98,000 (or 21%) as of November 30. The Challenge: As of November 30 it was determined that in order to end the year in the black we need \$166,000 in PAC Ministries Fund donations during the month of December. As of last Sabbath, we have received \$49,122 of that goal, leaving \$116,878 to go. During this Christmas season of gift giving and remembering mankind's Greatest Gift of all – Jesus Christ – we invite you to prayerfully consider a gift to our PAC Ministries Fund which provides for so many ministries to our church and community on the Ridge. The size of the gift does not matter (whether large or small); when combined with each others' gifts from our church family God will provide and multiply. What DOES matter, is the heart from which the gift is given. May the blessings of the Christ Child be yours this Christmas and always!
