

2020 Church Budget Monthly Goals

Just a little over one month ago (at the January 28 Church Business Meeting) the proposed 2020 Operating Budget for the *PAC Ministries Fund*, a.k.a. the Church Budget, was voted on and approved. This year's **TOTAL BUDGET of \$619,576** is a 1% decrease from the 2019 budget **while still providing for the following**:

\$270,000	Operating Funds to PAA Grades 9-12
	(our portion is now \$65,000 less per year than previously)
\$ 48,000	Worthy Student Funds to PAA
\$ 50,000	Operating Funds for the NEW Elementary School in Paradise
	(1 st Semester)

The same (or increased!) budget allowances for most ministries when compared to last year, plus:

- Reinstatement of the *Love Paradise* budget (\$500)
- Reinstatement of the Potluck Supplies budget (\$300)
- Reinstatement of Facility/Equipment Depreciation (\$5,781) on replacement and/or new items purchased since the fire

We are still following the same practice of reducing by half the January Goal for PAC Ministries Fund Donations while our members are paying off Christmas bills. This leaves our monthly goals for donations as follows:

\$ 31,031		\$ 516,310
\$ 77,450	December = 2020 TOTAL DONATIONS GOAL:	\$ 77,450 \$ 619,576
