COVID-19 Concerns

Thank you for your input concerning our church taking precautionary measures to protect our church members against COVID-19 (Corona Virus). The Church Staff have taken your suggestions into consideration. The decision was made at church board last night to suspend Worship Services and Vespers for the rest of this month. We will continue to monitor the situation and act accordingly. We have chosen to include the NCC recommendations for your information:

Taken from the Northern Lights | ssued March 5, 2020 ...

"During this unsettling time, as the world learns more about the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus), the Northern California Conference will do its best to provide evidence-based guidance to manage risk so that you can make sound decisions for your church, school, ministry, family and yourself.

Unfortunately, there is no one-size-fits-all approach because the NCC is spread over 30 counties, and each county is facing a different scenario. Staying current, using reliable sources of information, and planning will mitigate against panic. We recommend that everyone sign up to receive alert notification from your local public health department.

Please follow these three easy steps:

- 1. Go to: www.cdph.ca.gov/Pages/LocalHealthServicesAndOffices.aspx
- 2. Click on the name of your county, and you will be taken to its home page.
- 3. Sign up to receive alert notifications on your mobile device or through email. Each county calls its alert system something different, but you will find the sign-up form on your county's page.

2020 Church Budget Monthly Goals

Just a little over one month ago (at the January 28 Church Business Meeting) the proposed 2020 Operating Budget for the *PAC Ministries Fund*, a.k.a. the Church Budget, was voted on and approved. This year's **TOTAL BUDGET of \$619,576** is a 1% decrease from the 2019 budget **while still providing for the following**:

The same (or increased!) budget allowances for most ministries when compared to last year, plus:

- Reinstatement of the *Love Paradise* budget (\$500)
- Reinstatement of the Potluck Supplies budget (\$300)
- Reinstatement of Facility/Equipment Depreciation (\$5,781) on replacement and/or new items purchased since the fire

We are still following the same practice of reducing by half the January Goal for PAC Ministries Fund Donations while our members are paying off Christmas bills. This leaves our monthly goals for donations as follows:
