



Online Sabbath School Classes via Zoom! This Sabbath we're trying something different for Sabbath School classes that will hopefully allow for a better experience for everyone. If you want to participate, please follow these instructions:

Be prepared to join the Zoom call at 9:35 Sabbath morning so that classes can get started by 9:45 am. You will need to download the Zoom app if you haven't already.

1. <u>Click here</u> to join the Sabbath School "main lobby." If the link doesn't work, please copy and paste the following into your browser search bar:

- 2. Once you join the Zoom call, you will be in a general video "lobby" from which you will then be sorted into the appropriate "breakout room" where the SS class of your choosing will take place. When you join, you may automatically be muted so that the host doesn't become overwhelmed. If this happens, you will have to unmute yourself to speak and be heard by everyone in your class.
- 3. Find the chat button: if you're on a computer, it should be at the bottom of the screen, but if you're on a phone or tablet, you may have to click the three dots for "more" before you can access it. In chat, tell the host (this week, May 16, Joelle is the leader) which SS class you would like to join.
- 4. You will receive a notification on your screen asking you to join the Sabbath School class breakout room. Click it to join, and it will transfer you to that video call.
- 5. If you would like to switch Sabbath School classes, click on the "breakout rooms" button to select which class you would like to join. (If this option is unavailable, we apologize for the inconvenience.) If you would like to return to the lobby, click "Leave Breakout Room" at the bottom of your screen.

(Long story short: Cick the link to join, ask to be sorted into the SS of your choice, click Join Breakout Room when the notification pops up, and you're good!)





PAC Monthly Budget

Our Church Family Budget, the PAC Ministries Fund, provides for all our day-to-day expenses, including our portion of the Operating Funds for the PAA High School and, starting in August, the PAE (Paradise Elementary School). Please note that a budget is only good if it is funded—and that's where you come in! Each church member family should consider it a privilege to partner in the financial support of our commitments to the schools (\$26,500 each month to PAA and later \$8,333 per month to PAE) plus other church expenses (i.e. Utilities, Insurance, Salaries, Adventurers and Pathfinders, Sabbath School Expense, Youth/Children's/Intergenerational Ministries, etc.). As you can see from the graph below, we are averaging right around \$41,400 in total budget expenses each month. However, our monthly donations are falling far short of that.



We understand that these are difficult times for many families with the Coronavirus causing many layoffs. But for those of us who still remain employed, we ask that you prayerfully consider increasing your monthly contribution to our Church Budget, even if it's just \$10 per month; some may be able to do more. If we all pull together our combined sacrifices can ensure our success in providing Christian Education for our children and the community, while we continue serving the Ridge as the hands and feet of Jesus!
