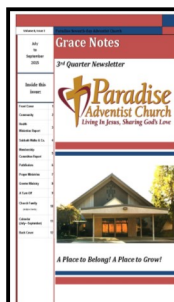

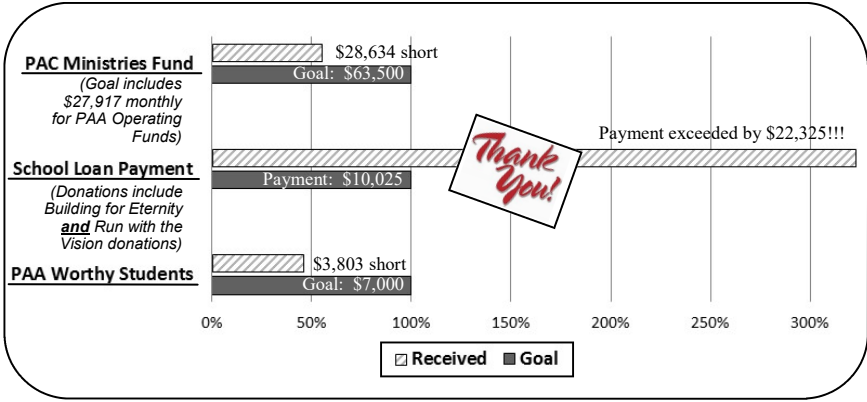

Our Church Finances

(as of May Month End)

This graph shows May's offerings received as of the last day of May for our customary monthly needs:



Church Budget: Received \$34,866 (54.91% of \$63,500 Goal)
PAA Mortgage: Received \$32,350 (322.69% of \$10,025 Payment) *
PAA Worthy Students: Received \$ 3,197 (45.67% of \$7,000 Goal)

* Includes \$13,681 received in the special May 19 Lambs' Offering Matching Challenge as well as \$15,430 in Run with the Vision donations in May.

As you can see by the above graph, your generosity in the May 19 Matching Lambs' Offering overwhelmingly surpassed the goal of \$7,000. We were able to put an additional \$19,456 directly on principle in May!

However, our May donations for the PAC Ministries Fund and PAA Worthy Students fell far short of their goals.

If you are able to give an extra \$5 or \$10 to help us catch up on this shortfall, we would be extremely grateful! Especially, as we head into the lean summer months when many of our members are away on vacations.
